GROUP A

This job group is for those interested in animals and plants. You may enjoy caring for animals, learning about growing food, or spending time with companion animals. Entry level jobs could include: Kennel Assistant; Seasonal Agritourism Guide; Equine Barn Assistant; Greenhouse Worker; Lawn Crew; Vet Assistant; Ranch Hand; or Pet Sitter.

GROUP B

The home is an important part of your life. These jobs use skills that are important to people's day to day lives. Entry level jobs could include: Retail Sales Associate; Boutique Stylist; Day Care Assistant; Nutrition Shake Shop Server; Grocery Store Stock Clerk; Fast Food Restaurant Cook; Restaurant Dishwasher; or Bank Teller.

GROUP C

Science is fascinating! These jobs give you a chance to explore the world around us. Entry level jobs could include: Game Room Attendant; Water Sports Ride Attendant; Gold Caddy; Tutor; Carpenter's Assistant; Electrician's Assistant; Vehicle Detailer; or Florist Assistant.

GROUP D

Communicating and share with others can be lots of fun. Jobs in this group require communication skills. Entry level jobs could include: Restaurant Server; Snow Cone Stand Worker; Camp Counselor; Lifeguard; Swimming Instructor; Grocery Bagger; Librarian Assistant; or Museum worker.

Responsibilities may include, but are not limited to:


- ·Attend to customers' needs and questions
