## Service Projects

ALL club/county service project donations and reports are due to the State 4-H Office by **July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024** to be considered for State 4-H Spirit Contest. This means received NOT postmarked. County donations/reports not turned in by **July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024** are greatly appreciated but **WILL NOT** be counted for the Spirit Contest.

### Change for Change – 25 points

The total points will be determined by the amount collected by the district.

### Pull for Kids – 25 points

The total points will be determined by the number of pounds of pull tabs collected by the district.

**NO PULL TABS WILL BE COLLECTED AT STATE 4-H ROUNDUP.**

### District Promotional Video – 20 points

Each district will be allowed to submit one video that could be used as a 4-H promotional video. Entries are due on **July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024**. Rules are below:

- One video entry per district
- Videos must be no longer than 2 minutes
- If music is used, it must be royalty free music
- District Program Specialists will submit a list of a names of 4-H members appearing in the video for release purposes.
- Entries should be uploaded to the Microsoft Form sent to District Program Specialists.

### District Color Day Shirts – 10 points

During the Thursday morning assembly, the district that best represents their assigned color for the color day shirt contest will receive 10 points. There will be no penalty for State 4-H Ambassadors or State Council who are wearing their uniform for the assembly.

**West District = RED      Southeast District = BLACK**

**Northeast District = WHITE**

### Roundup Chalk Art – 10 points

Each district will have a designated space of 5'x5' outside of the University Commons.

Chalk, container with water, paper towels and masking tape will be provided. No other equipment or supplies can be used. Districts can select Roundup delegates from their district to design and carryout art.

### District Chant – 10 points

The chant content must promote the Oklahoma 4-H Roundup theme “4-H: The Fast Lane to Your Future”.

Presentation of chant will be determined by creativity and how clearly the words are understood. No props, signs, face paints or noisemakers are allowed.

## BONUS POINTS

### Bucket Pass – 10 points

Bucket pass will happen at Pistol Pete’s Pit Stop on Wednesday evening. Each district will have two buckets and the district with the most money in their bucket wins the bonus points.
