Payne County 4-H Archery Club would like to invite all 4-H certified archers to participate in this archery contest to benefit their club and the **2024 Oklahoma 4-H National Team**. Profits will be divided between the club and the national team.

- 1. Oklahoma 4-H archery safety rules will be followed for this contest.
- 2. Bow poundage will not be checked prior to the contest. Any bow may be checked by contest officials to determine the bow draw is no more than 60 pounds. Any bow found in violation will cause the archer to be disqualified from the contest.
- 3. There will be three bow types that can be used: Compound, Recurve and Genesis.
- 4. Compound, Genesis and Recurve bows will shoot at 20 yards for all age divisions. Junior Division Genesis bows will shoot 6 ends at 10 yards and the 6 ends at 15 yards.
- 5. Participants may choose between 5-Spot target or 40 cm target. Junior Division Genesis bow participants will shoot at 60 cm targets.
- 6. All archers will shoot 5 arrow ends. Archery contest will consist of 12 ends for a total of 60 shots.
- 7. 2¹/₂ minutes will be allowed for each 5-arrow end. Archers will be given a 30 second warning before the end of the time period.
- 8. Archers must draw on target, no sky drawing is allowed. Archers will only be warned once about sky drawing. Additional violations will cause the participate to be removed from the contest.
- 9. Archers assigned to the same target will work together to score the arrows shot. Archer can not score their own arrows.
- 10. Individual archers are responsible to check their score for each arrow has been properly recorded before arrows are pulled.
- 11. The archer is responsible to check the math for their scorecard to determine their final score is correct. Scores will be checked by contest officials. If too many points were awarded, final score will be corrected. If too few points were awarded, then the archer's score will be what was signed-off on and turned into contest officials.
- 12. Certificates of Awards will be presented to the top three individuals for each bow type and age division. Teams will consist of either 3 or 4 members. Top three scores will be used to determine the team's score. All team members must shoot the same type of bow. Certificates of Award will be presented to the top team for each type of bow and age division.
- 13. Only archers and contest officials will be allowed in Expo Hall during competition!
