Eligibility	This competition is open to all competitors who are US citizens meeting the age criteria. All Oklahoma State JOSOC competitors must be members of USA Shooting
Residence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form • Residents are eligible for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place USA Shooting State Champion medallions • Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a current and valid driver’s license. If the competitor does not have a driver’s license, residency is then defined as to where the competitor’s parents/guardians reside • Nonresidents may compete for invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so. Non-residents are not eligible for state awards
Entry	Only scores from a registered State Junior Olympic match will count for invitation to the National Junior Olympic Championships. Shooters may not compete in more than one state JOSOC. Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSOC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSOC, and those who cannot attend their own state JOSOC, will be allowed to enter as a non-resident in another state. Non-residents should declare their home state on their Entry Form and are not eligible for state resident awards
Categories	The following categories will be used for the competition: (Based on the age the competitor the first day of competition) U 21 (formerly Junior J1) U 18 (formerly Intermediate Junior J2) U15 (formerly Sub-Junior J3)
Classification	Shooter classifications will not be used
Rules	International Shooting Sports Federation (ISSF), latest edition, will govern. Please see last page of this program for additional information on rules applicable for this match
Distance	Air Rifle and Air Pistol - 10 meters – Athena Electronic Target 3X20 Smallbore - 50 Feet – Paper targets
Courses of Fire	Air Rifle and Air Pistol: Women and Men will shoot 60 competition shots. This event will be fired at 10 meters on Electronic Targets if possible. Paper targets scored by Orion will be used if needed. Note: The combined Preparation and Sighting Period of 15 minutes starts before the published start time of the event. Scoring will be in integer (whole ring) values. Electronic Target course of fire: Call to line (20 minutes prior to Prep/Sigher) Prep/Sighter period (15 minutes) Record Firing 60 Shots (1 hour, 15 minutes)

	<p>Paper target course of fire: Call to line (20 minutes prior to Prep/Sighter) Sighters + 20 record shots (40 minutes) Target Change Sighters + 20 record shots (40 minutes) Target Change Sighters + 20 record shots (40 minutes)</p> <p>Three Position Small Bore Rifle: Women and Men will shoot a 3x20 (20 shots kneeling, 20 shots prone, 20 shots standing). This event will be fired on paper targets at 50 FEET. Scoring will be in integer (whole ring) values.</p> <p>Course of fire 3X20 (2 hours - Block time): Call to line (20 minutes prior to Prep/Sighter) 3X20 (Kneeling, Prone, Standing) Kneeling – (Sighters + 20 Record shots) Prone – (Sighters + 20 Record Shots) Standing – (Sighters + 20 Record Shots)</p>
Time Limits	See Above
Scoring Challenges	The protest fee is \$1. If the protest is upheld, the fee will be returned
Ties	All ties will be broken in accordance with USA Shooting Rules
Participation Pins	A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor
Awards	USA Shooting will provide a gold medallion for the top resident individual, silver medallion for the 2nd place resident individual and a bronze medallion for the 3rd place resident individual
Entry Fees	The regular entry fee will be \$25.00 per event. \$12 of the fee goes to USA Shooting. The remaining fees go to Sapulpa High School for match supplies. Entry fees to be paid at match registration. Make checks out to: Robert Oberle
