

CSI Day Camp Suspect Cards

General Instructions / Recommendations:

Print out one set of the suspect cards per group. Cut different evidence pieces apart so they are easy to distribute/share among group members (see dotted lines).

Use a manila envelopes to keep suspect cards together.

Each crime scene is designed to have a different suspect, this way groups won't be able to "cheat" off one another.

The last 2 pages include blank suspect cards for customization.

Favorite cookies: Four-leaf clover shaped sugar cookies

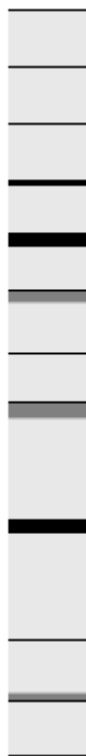

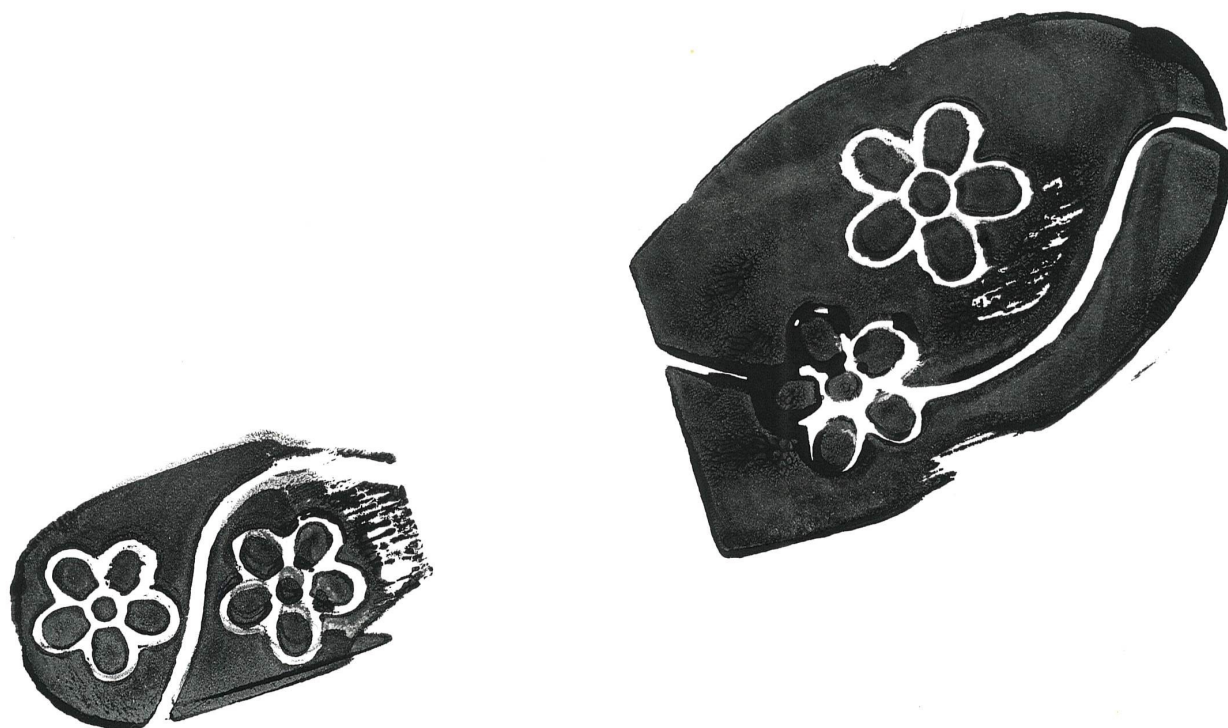

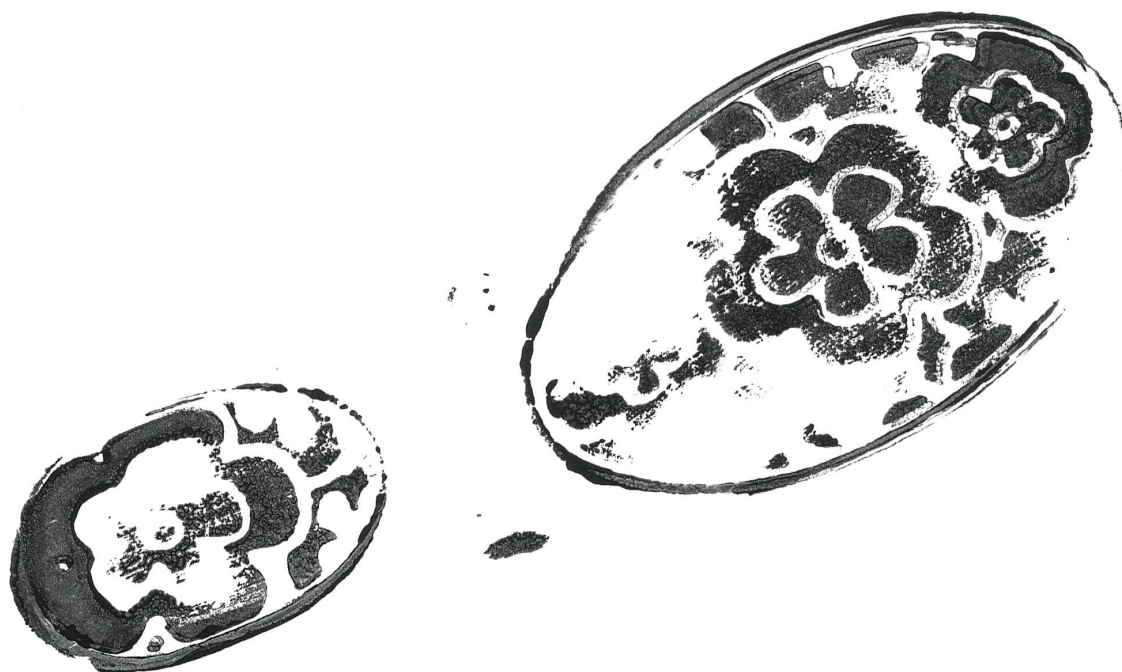
